



STUDENT BEHAVIOR POLICY

To ensure all participants and instructors make the most of their time together, we have incorporated a behavior policy. A clear understanding of cooperation and respect is necessary for course enjoyment. The following are behavior expectations from participants in any of the EDGE programs. Included are steps that will be followed by instructors and administrators to maintain this policy. Should proper behavior be disregarded we will refer to these guidelines.

The behavior policy is to be read together by the participant and parent(s). Signatures are required indicating each have read and understand the terms and procedures. This form must be completed and returned with your registration in order to process your enrollment within EDGE programming.

Behavior Guidelines

- To participate fully and have fun
- Foul or rude language will not be tolerated
- Patience and cooperation when doing group activities
- Respect for your instructor
- Respect for peers in your group
- Respect for school and program property
- Touching of items in rooms where programs take place will not be tolerated
- Follow directions given by your instructor at all times
- Wait quietly outside course room until admitted by instructor (no horseplay, pushing, shoving, etc.)
- Be aware that instructors and peers in your program want to teach and learn, disruptive behavior will restrict this process
- All participants are required to help with the clean up of program materials. You will help to ensure that the room you are using is left in the same condition that you found it. This duty is not the sole responsibility of the instructor, remember being part of a group is being part of a team. Dismissal will occur only once this task is complete.
- Remember this program is not a right but a privilege

Corrective Procedures

(To be done in stages where behavior is not modified)

- **Instructors will identify the problem and give a verbal warning**
- **Instructors will ask individuals disregarding the guidelines to take a time out/cool down period**
- **Contact the EDGE Coordinator to contact parents to discuss the nature of the behavior problem**
- **Removal from the program**
