Dear Parents/Guardians,

We have been advised that a member of our school community has tested positive for COVID-19. The individual was last at school on Wednesday, December 22nd during the communicability period, close contacts have been notified. Public Health officials have not yet completed their case investigation.

As of yesterday's news conference, we know that provincial case numbers are going up and that there is a strain on the health-care system. Wait times for tests and results have increased. Anyone who has someone in their social network who recently tested positive, who is awaiting test results or who is at home with symptoms should consider themselves a contact and shouldn't go to group gatherings.

Dr. Roussin has encouraged those under the age of 40 and those without underlying medical conditions, if they have respiratory symptoms – cold-like symptoms, flu-like symptoms, they can assume they have Omicron. All are being advised to **STAY HOME AND ISOLATE for 10 days if symptomatic.**

Please monitor for symptoms and stay safe this holiday season. We will inform you if we find out anything further from Public Health in the coming days.
