

ATTENDING SCHOOL DURING COVID-19:


What you need to know



**YOUR CHILD CAN**
Attend school

They are symptom free and are not an unvaccinated close contact of a confirmed COVID case



**YOUR CHILD MUST STAY HOME**
If the student is showing symptoms as described on the COVID-19 screening test

Sick and NOT COVID tested

Sick and COVID tested


They must stay home for **10 days** from symptom onset


If results are negative, the student can return after **24 hours of being symptom-free**

**YOUR CHILD MUST STAY HOME**
If the student or household member is a close contact to a COVID case

All unvaccinated family members must self-isolate for 10 days. The close contact will be asked to take a COVID test at the time of notification and 7 days after the last exposure to a case

**POSITIVE COVID TEST**
The entire household must follow Public Health direction

**NEGATIVE COVID TEST**
Close contact must continue to self-isolate for the entire 10 days – household members can return to school if the close contact test was done a minimum of seven days after exposure

**TRAVEL**
Each family is responsible to follow the rules that relate to their destination, purpose for travel and vaccination status.
