Re: School Community Notification Letter

Good Evening Families of Edmund Partridge School,

We were recently informed that a member of our school community has tested positive for COVID-19. The individual was last at school on Wednesday, December 22nd during the communicability period.

Public health officials have not yet completed their case investigation. Based on our assessment of the situation, close contacts have been identified and notified. However, since the community member and administration have not heard from public health, we can not yet confirm this assessment.

At this point if you did not receive a letter of close contact, please simply monitor your own child for symptoms and keep your children at home if symptomatic. Dr Roussin has also recommended that anyone under 40 with any symptoms simply assume that they have contracted the Omicron variant and isolate.

Once I hear from public health, only close contacts will receive a copy of the official isolation letter. This decision is made by public health officials, and we are following their protocols. The larger community will receive a general notice of the recent case.

We hope everyone stays well and healthy through the holidays and maintains the health protocols in place so we can all return safely to school.
