Required Qualifications:

- Licensed Interprovincial Red Seal Journeyperson's Plumbing trade qualification required.
- 10 years' experience installing and servicing plumbing systems, devices, and equipment
- Gas Fitter-Domestic license.
- Backflow and Cross Connection Testing certification required.
- Valid Driver's License, abstract required annually
- Physically capable of performing all duties as required in this classification

Primary Responsibilities Include:

- Repair and maintain all Divisional plumbing systems, devices and equipment, including installation of equipment and planning and completing small projects
- Inspection of outside contractor's installation work, supervision and/or liaison with assistant(s), contractor(s) and other divisional personnel
- Operate and maintain various power tools and mechanical equipment
- Assisting other tradespersons as required, heavy lifting, etc.
