Student Parent Support Workers serve as primary advocates for Wayfinders' students at school and in community. Applicants need to possess recent & relevant mentorship experiences working with youth and families in culturally diverse communities.

Desired Qualifications:

- Relevant experience in the past 5 years working with adolescent youth. This experience should include service as a positive role model, able to advocate and plan mentorship experiences
- Relevant post-secondary education supporting an understanding of adolescent youth, their families and caregivers
- Relevant advocacy work within the education system
- Knowledge of Indigenous, Newcomer, CRS, LGBTTQ* and low SES communities and realities
- Skills and knowledge in program development in areas related to cultural programming and cross-cultural experiences, health and healthy living, identity-affirming programming, leadership and service-learning as well as nutrition and gardening.
- Strong verbal and written communication skills
- Ability to network with various professional, community members and organizations
- Ability to work a varied schedule; afternoons, evenings and some weekends
- Possess current clear criminal records and child abuse registry checks; and
- Possess a valid driver's license.
