

## COMMUNITY RESOURCE PERSONS

The Board encourages the enrichment of curriculum and the widening of educational horizons by inviting persons or groups from outside the school with special knowledge or talents to address students, provided that in the opinion of the school, such contribution is relevant to the educational program and does not interfere with the objectivity of the school.

The time taken by the resource person or group and the limitations imposed by the necessity to schedule the regular program of studies must be considered when arranging for visits.

Approval for each visit or program must be given by the principal of the school concerned. Programs of an on-going nature must have the prior approval of the superintendent or his/her designate, and must be reported to the Board.

It is expected that speakers or programs which, in the opinion of the superintendent, may be controversial will be reported to the Board prior to their commencement.
