Electrical Trades & Technology is open to anyone who meets the requirements:

- Interest in working in the electrical trades
- Students must be 21 or under by the start of classes
- Completion of grade 11 core courses (done in semester one of grade 11 year)
- Completion of a Career Ready application form
- Presentation of a certified transcript of marks, cover letter, reference letter, resume and fee if applicable
- Participation in an orientation
- Math 30S and/or 40S mark of 70% is recommended (applied math, pre-cal or physics)

Individuals who have completed grade 12, are an adult learner or reside outside the division are encouraged to submit an application. A registration fee may apply depending if you are a graduate or live out of Seven Oaks School Division catchment.
