Electrical Trades & Technology is open to anyone who meets the requirements:

- Interest in working in the electrical trades
- Students must be 21 or under by the start of classes
- Completion of grade 11 core courses (done in semester one of grade 11 year)
- Completion of a CVE application form
- Presentation of a certified transcript of marks, cover letter, reference letter, resume and fee if applicable
- Participation in an orientation
- Math 30S and/or 40S mark of 70% is recommended (applied, pre-cal or physics)

Individuals who have completed grade 12, are an adult learner or reside outside the division are encouraged to submit an application. A registration fee may apply depending if you are a graduate or live out of Seven Oaks School Division catchment.

all in a day's work

This course starts in the second semester of the school year and continues through the end of the first semester of the following year. You will spend time in the classroom attaining basic skills and learning theory needed to get started in conjunction with practical lab experience, giving you the necessary skills to continue your apprenticeship.

Under the guidance of your instructor and experienced electricians, you will acquire and demonstrate skills such as:

- Motor controls
- Alternating & direct current fundamentals
- Electrical & power tool safety
- Residential & commercial wiring practices
- Canadian Electrical Code
- Alternative Energy
