The Refrigeration & Air Conditioning program is open to anyone who meets the requirements:

- Interest in working in refrigeration and air conditioning
- Completion of grade 11 core courses (done in semester one of grade 11 year)
- Completion of a CVE application form
- Presentation of a certified transcript of marks, cover letter, reference letter, resume and fee if applicable
- Participation in an orientation
- Math 30S and/or 40S mark of 70% is recommended (physics and/or applied/pre-cal)
- English 30S and/or 40S mark of 70% is recommended

Individuals who have completed Grade 12, are an adult learner or reside outside the division are encouraged to submit an application. A registration fee may apply depending if you are a graduate or live out of Seven Oaks School Division catchment.

This course starts in the second semester of the school year and continues through the end of the first semester of the following year. You will spend time in the classroom attaining skills and learning theory needed to get started.

Under the guidance of your instructor and experienced workers in the industry you will demonstrate skills such as:

- Performing a system inspection
- Performing basic maintenance and service
- Completing repairs and servicing
- Completing preventative maintenance procedures
- Performing maintenance related to seasonal concerns
- Understanding and using theory applied to operating systems
- Communicating and working with peers, employers and customers
- Thinking logically and making decisions
- Working independently or as part of a team
- The ability for life-long learning to enhance their time management skills
- Mechanical aptitude and manual dexterity
- Problem-solving

Refrigeration & Air Conditioning Technician introduces you to a variety of career opportunities.

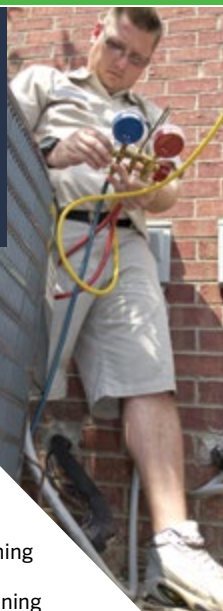
