Currently the only positions in Food Services are casual and there is no guaranteed hours. Shifts range from 7.75 hours (day shift) and 3.5-4 hours (evening shift). Typically casual shifts available are evenings and weekends. Some shift are pre-booked (schedule is posted for 2 weeks) and other shifts are calls to replace sick calls (find out day before or day of). Areas we would likely train include maintenance areas (such as dishmachine maintenance, pots, floors), production (salad prep, sandwich prep, short order, meat slicing) and trayline (assembly line preparing patient trays and cleaning patient trays in dishroom. Hourly pay ranges starts from \$14.479 – 16.751 with annual increases (based on hours worked). As casual employee you acquire seniority therefore can apply for part-time and full-time shifts as they become available because a casual employee is considered an internal applicant. Positions are given to employees based on seniority.

Key things we look for: Food Services work experience; Food Handlers Certificate (asset); grade 10; availability (preferably evenings & weekends); and on application check off casual.
