There's a new Director at the Seven Oaks Education Foundation, and his name is Albert Yanofsky.

Albert may be the new director, but he's

been a part of the Division for years.

"All three of our children, Jocelyne, Aaron and Evelyn have attended Seven Oaks School Division schools throughout their education," says Albert. "I have also enjoyed volunteering and handing out scholarships as co-chair of many Garden City Collegiate Parent Councils – many with my good friend Harriet Zaidman."

Albert isn't the only one who has been active in education in the Seven Oaks School Division. His wife, Sharon, worked with him for several years, coordinating a successful Parents' Support Group at Victory School in the evenings. The program was specifically about providing assistance to Division parents and families who have children with special needs.

"What I remember most about those special years was the tremendous support we received from Edie Wilde and the entire Seven Oaks School Division," recalls Albert.

Having only recently retired after 36 years of teaching in the Winnipeg School Division, Albert now enjoys the opportunity to spend more time with his family and friends, as well as keeping busy with a host of other activities.

His list includes swimming, working out at Shapes, growing milkweed and studying monarch butterflies, raising walking stick insects and supporting his family and brother, Arnold. "All that and cleaning up the garage occupy much of my time!" says the always-active Albert.



Add to that his volunteer work with Special Olympics, the Society for Manitobans with Disabilities (SMD), Manitoba Marathon, Jewish Child and Family Services and Continuity Care events – PLUS future trips to Europe, Mexico and Australia – and you might wonder if Albert is really retired at all.

With all that's going on, how did he become Director of the Seven Oaks Education Foundation?

"With continuous and friendly encouragement and persuasion over the past two years from Harriet Zaidman, Irv Simmonds, and Avrum Senensky," he says, though he likely didn't require that much encouragement. possible to provide students, who have various challenging needs, with realistic opportunities to also apply for and obtain scholarships."


