As teachers and staff in the Division, they know how scholarships make a huge difference to so many students. Because a scholarship is more than a monetary reward. It's a recognition of hard work and encouragement to continue pursuing education and passions - like music. In the near future, people will be able to experience more arts and music fundraisers in the beautiful new Seven Oaks Performing Arts Centre.
