You will be requested to provide two-pieces of ID. When applying for a Criminal Record Search Certificate please request <u>vulnerable sector verification</u>. A Criminal Record Search Certificate without the vulnerable sector screening will <u>not be accepted</u> . Please provide the original document as we take copies and return original to you. Document must be current (within 1 year).

Child Abuse Registry Check -To make a request for a Child Abuse Registry for Employment purposes, you have two options: Apply Online: https://web22.gov.mb.ca/AbuseRegistry Apply in person: 1st floor - 777 Portage Ave, Wpg R3G 0N3 Please provide us with the original document as we will take copies and return original to you. Document must be current (within 1 year).
