Children born in 2019 can start Kindergarten in September 2024. You must register at your catchment school for Kindergarten. If you are unsure what your catchment school is, feel free to call our office at 204-694-8688. When registering, you will need to attach your child's birth certificate or passport, as well as proof of current address (2 pieces i.e. offer to purchase, lease agreement, property tax bill, hydro bill, water bill, etc.), plus any other important documents (PR card, work permit/study permit, custody arrangements etc).



Student School Attendance Matters

Attend today! Achieve Tomorrow!



Missing a day of school here and there may not seem like much, but absences add up!

IF YOUR CHILD MISSES 2 DAYS A MONTH

- They will MISS 15 DAYS of school a year.
 - They will MISS 1 YEAR of school by the end of Grade 12.

IF YOUR CHILD MISSES 4 DAYS A MONTH

- They will MISS 30 DAYS of school a year.
 - (This is MORE THAN ONE MONTH of school)
- They will MISS 2 YEARS of school by the end of Grade 12.

IF YOUR CHILD IS 10 MINUTES LATE FOR CLASS EVERY DAY

They will miss 33 HOURS of instruction over the school year.

What is the Canada Education Savings Grant?

The Canada Education Savings Grant (CESG) is a government savings incentive in addition to the Canada Learning Bond for children from families of all incomes.

If contributions are made into a child's RESP before they turn 15, the government will match 20% of the first \$2 500 contributed.

Families who make a low to moderate income are eligible to receive an extra 10-20% matched on the first \$500 contributed!



Did you know?

Children with even just \$500 of savings are four times more likely to graduate and three times more likely to enroll in post-secondary education.

What is the Canada Learning Bond?

The Canada Learning Bond (CLB) is a government savings incentive to help families who make a low income kickstart savings for their child's postsecondary education.

Eligibility

A child is eligible for the CLB if:

- They are born in 2004 or later
- They have lived in Canada before they turned 15
- Are from a family who make a low income*

*\$50 197 in 2022 – but this is adjusted each year for inflation and is higher for families with more than 3 children.

Children only need to be eligible for just one year to qualify for the minimum of \$500. The most a child can get from the Canada Learning bond is \$2000.



This money can be claimed Retroactively. That means that even after a child turns 15, they can still

apply up until the day before they turn 21 years old!



Frequently Asked Questions:

What can this money be used for?

When the beneficiary is accepted into an accredited post-secondary program, including college, university, trade school, apprenticeship programs and CEGEP, they can use the money in their RESP for education expenses such as tuition, textbooks, supplies, transportation, and lodging.

What happens if my child does not end up going to post-secondary education?

The RESP can remain open for 35 years before it needs to be closed. Some people need more time to decide their educational path.

When an RESP is closed, any money that you contributed is returned to you, and any education incentives are returned to the government.

What happens if my child has already turned 18?

18 year olds have until the day before they turn 21 to apply for the Canada Learning Bond. Since it is retroactive, they will receive the full amount they are eligible for in one payment.

How do you access the Canada Learning Bond?

If you are eligible for the Canada Learning Bond, you will need to have a Registered Education Savings Plan (RESP) where government contributions can be deposited.

Financial institutions offer two kinds of RESPs:

- Individual plans have only one beneficiary
- Family plans can have more than one related beneficiary – this is ideal for families with more than one child.

Open one today, and watch your savings grow!


What do you need to do?

- 1. Make sure you have a <u>Social</u> <u>Insurance Number</u> for you AND your child(ren).
- 2. <u>Make an appointment</u> at the Financial Institution or RESP provider of your choice.
- 3. Open a no-fee nocontribution RESP and apply for the Canada Learning Bond and/or the Canada Education Savings Grant.
- 4. If you are eligible for the CESG, <u>make contributions</u> when you can!
- 5. Continue to <u>file your income</u> taxes every year to keep receiving the Canada Learning Bond when you are eligible.

What is the CLB?

The Canada Learning Bond (CLB) is money the Government of Canada will add to a Registered Education Savings Account (RESP) to help pay for studies after high school. It's completely free and you do not need to add any money to receive the CLB.

How much \$ is available?

Eligible children can receive \$500 - \$2,000 deposited directly into their RESP.

Who is eligible?

Children who:

- were born after January 1, 2004 or later.
- · are residents of Canada (ie. PR Card, Work Permit). •have a Birth Certificate and Social Insurance Number (SIN).

We can help you get a Birth Certificate, Social Insurance Number (SIN) and choose an RESP Provider.
