





Happy Holidays from Healthy Smile Happy Child

Enjoying some treats during the holidays is great!

Just remember these tips to reduce your child's risk of cavities:

- Brush those sugar bugs away with a soft toothbrush for two minutes twice a day
 - Don't forget to floss to get in between teeth where a toothbrush can't reach!
- Having holiday treats is best right after family meal time
 - Constant snacking increases the acidic conditions in the mouth leading to an increased risk for cavities
- Soft bristled toothbrushes and fluoridated toothpaste make great stocking stuffers!

 Don't forget to replace your toothbrush every 3 months or after your child was sick.
