




**November 8<sup>th</sup>:** Remembrance Day Assembly at 12:15pm. We welcome two former Elwick students as special performers. All families welcome!


**November 8<sup>th</sup>:** Our Middle Years Choir will be attending the Maples Choir Concert at SOPAC!






