<b>The Winnipeg Humane Society's Animal Welfare Scholarship</b>	<p><b>Eligibility Criteria:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All individuals aged between 15-18 years, and who demonstrate an outstanding effort in improving the welfare of non-companion animals, are encouraged to apply. This can include, but is not limited to: pursuing a secondary education relating to animal welfare, developing a community project that improves animal welfare and/or the environment, advocacy efforts towards key issue(s) affecting animals and/or the environment, and more.</li><li>• Applicants must be a resident of Manitoba, Canada.</li><li>• Applicants must not be a previous winner of this scholarship.</li><li>• Two references (non-family or friend) must be provided in the submission.</li><li>• A written submission (between 300-600 words) that outlines the applicant's efforts in improving non-companion animal welfare, and how the funds will benefit the applicant if chosen.
