Room 6 is all a flutter with the arrival of their Painted Lady Butterfly larva. Eric Carle must have known a thing or two about butterflies when he wrote his story "The Very Hungry Caterpillar" because many of the

larvae have grown over night and are now nearly 1 cm long. The students will be tracking the caterpillars' growth as it grows from a larva to a pupa, secures itself into a chrysalis and finally emerges as a beautiful butterfly. The whole process takes about 3 weeks. At the end of June we will have a releasing ceremony to release our butterflies back into nature. We are all very excited!

Yoga Theme Day

Our final theme day of the school year will be a yoga day on Friday, June 13. Yoga is a practice that encourages mindfulness, body and breath awareness, and allows for a sense of inner calmness. Students can wear comfortable, athletic clothing or a yoga outfit. We will end the day by participating in a school wide yoga class outside after lunch, so students should bring a beach towel to use as a yoga mat, and may want to bring sunscreen, a hat and sunglasses.
