Stop, Drop and Go

Thank you for helping to make our community safer. More parents are stopping quickly, dropping their children off safely and going on their way. The Winnipeg Parking Authority has also been more present around our school to help make sure that school zone traffic laws are being adhered to!

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Governor Semple is working in partnership with Dr. Paul Betts from the University of Winnipeg. Paul is a math professor at the U of W who is focusing his attention on how children engage with math. Together, with our teachers, he will be looking at best teach-

ing strategies that help to build children's Critical Numerical Competency. Dr. Betts will be here twice a month working in classrooms and meeting with teachers.

Reminders and Information

- Please help your children remember to keep toys and objects from home at home. We would hate to see children lose things that are of value to them and keeping them at home is the best way to ensure this does not happen.
