- We have seen tremendous success with our Stop Drop and Go area outside the front doors on Morrison! Thank you to everyone who has been using it.
- Please be reminded that the crosswalk area directly across the street of the front doors is a NO STOPPING zone. We have had children trying to use the cross walk appropriately but stopped cars in that zone block the view of the crosswalk for moving vehicles and have caused dangerous situations.
- Outside of the time directly before and after school when busses are running, you may use the bus loop to park for short periods of time but engines must be turned off as there is fresh air intake along that wall and we can't have exhaust fumes entering the classrooms. Thank you so very much for your compliance with this request.
