

# École Seven Oaks Middle School Library Updates

Due to the changes implemented by the Manitoba Government on Monday October 26, 2020, the following changes are being made to your library:

Taylor Smith's class is currently occupying our space; therefore, all the book shelves are currently unavailable.

**There will be no library classes, and no one is allowed to come in and browse books**, teachers must email both Krysta and Analeigh with their requests. The requested books will then be delivered the next day if the materials are at all available.

**The printer is available before school, during lunch, or after school.** Otherwise it is unavailable.

Each class will have a designated "Return" box for students' books. Krysta and Analeigh will come around at 3:00pm each day to collect the books.

It is at this time the library is encouraging online research over book/physical research. This is due to inaccessibility to our shelves. However, we do have access to the following subjects: history, travel, geography, biographies, and religion & mythology. Novel sets are available as well. If you require books with these subjects, please email Krysta and Analeigh, who will then deliver them to you.
