We will require volunteers to assemble the treat bags on Monday, October 26th. All volunteers must self screen prior to attending and should not volunteer if they are unwell on the day. Volunteers must wear masks and gloves will be provided. Treat bags will sit for a minimum of 72 hours before being distributed to the students on Friday, October 30th.
