Our students will be a part of several ongoing surveys and assessments this year. For kindergarten students, there is the EDI (Early Development Instrument) completed by kindergarten teachers. A random group of grade 4 students will be taking the Trends in International Mathematics and Science Study (TIMSS) and a random group of grade 8 students will be taking the Pan Canadian Assessment Program (PCAP). Our grade 4-8 students will complete the Our School survey that talks about school climate and improving student outcomes.

Our Tap Dance club has been up and running for several months now. Our Bhangra Dance club will be starting in the near future and Pow Wow club will be starting after spring break.
