What is the CLB?

The **Canada Learning Bond** (**CLB**) is money the Government of Canada will add to a **Registered Education Savings Account** (**RESP**) to help pay for studies after high school. *It's completely free and you do not need to add any money to receive the CLB.*

How much \$ is available?

Eligible children can receive **\$500 - \$2,000 deposit**ed directly into their RESP.

Who is eligible?

Children who:

- were born after January 1, 2004 or later.
- are residents of Canada.
- have a Birth Certificate and Social Insurance Number (SIN).

We can help you get a free Birth Certificate, Social Insurance Number (SIN) and choose an RESP Provider.
