Our school registration is online for parents to complete for new students and kindergarten students. Transportation forms for next year will be available in the next few weeks. With the return of warmer weather, we can be doing more teaching and learning outside. Important skills that need to be learned by all include cleaning up the yard and the community. In West St. Paul, we know that winter winds can scatter garbage, recycling, leaves and branches. Learning to clean up this debris safely is great for our yards and the community. I can still fondly remember my father teaching me how to rake the lawn so that thatch and debris were collected without tearing out the grass roots. Sitting down with a drink to admire our work afterwards is one of my favourite childhood memories. Be sure to involve your children in outdoor chores and enjoy working together.

We continue to have a staff member at the front doors of the school to meet students and parents coming in to drop off and pick up homework. Many parents and students have picked up personal items from lockers and classrooms. Using proper social distancing guidelines, we have allowed parents/students to collect personal items from the school.

For those parents who were required to pay bus fees and paid for the full school year, a list has been compiled and forwarded to the Board Office for processing and reimbursement for unused bussing will be coming from the School Board Office in the mail within 2-3 weeks.
