Staff and students arrived back feeling energized and regenerated ready to focus upon goals for the second term.



January 19, the teacher team of Alyssa Talbot, Billie Cross and Leanne Yeo were invited to attend the Administration Meeting where they shared the details of the Red Sucker Lake Initiative with the Seven Oaks School Division's Administrators. Via Power Point the ladies explained the origin of the idea from Billie's "I had a dream" perspective to its evolution to "We have a dream".

What began as an extension of shoebox gifts took flight into flying the 526 km to deliver those packages to the community's children and having the opportunity to tour and interact with community members at

the local "TV" station. What a learning experience! Exploration of the Northern Store revealed the challenges northern families face in feeding their children healthy food

when the subsidized price of 4L of milk is \$8.59 and a 454g clamshell of strawberries is \$13.99. The children were thrilled to be visited by Santa and receive their own Christmas packages. Curricular connections had been the focus of the teaching for much of the fall term to give the children of West St. Paul a glimpse into life in the northern community.
