Key Policies

BALL/SHIRT: Campers will only receive 1 camp soccer ball & 1 tshirt. If a camper attends 5 or more weeks of camp, he/she will receive a 2nd ball & tshirt on his/her 5th week of camp.

INCLEMENT WEATHER: While camp will continue at designated shelter or indoor facility until inclement weather clears, soccer and active games will likely not be played indoors. There are no refunds due to bad weather.

LATE PICKUP: Pick up beyond 5:00 pm (for full day sessions) will be charged at \$10 per 15 minutes. We reserve the right to ask you to withdraw from camp for multiple late pick ups past 5:00pm.

TRANSPORTATION not provided: We do not offer pick up or drop off service, however, if camp must travel offsite for any reason, we will arrange bussing and your onsite Supervisor will notify you.

Camp Sessions

At Royal City, we're much more than just a soccer camp. We have 2 different sessions you can register for. Campers will build confidence and creativity as we foster an inclusive, engaging and active summer camp experience. We recognize that many of our campers attend for multiple weeks of camp, so we accommodate this by introducing weekly themes and vary the activities and skill exercises. We strive to provide the best camp experience for your child.

Morning Sessions 9 am - 12 noon

Morning sessions are geared towards campers who just want a half day program and prefer the soccer focus. Programming consists of learning and playing soccer daily which includes a daily warm up, individual skill development, fun team games, soccer scrimmages and mini-Royal Cups. Campers are grouped by age, size (& ability where possible) in groups sizes are about 10 campers to 1 staff (these ratios are subject to change).

Full Day Sessions 9 am - 4 pm

Our full days sessions are the most popular sessions families register for. These sessions combine the morning sessions (as outlined above) with a fun afternoon session (that may or may not include a leisure swim depending upon the option you select during registration). All campers will play a variety of camp games in the afternoon. Campers who choose the swim option will also get a chance to swim at the nearby pool each afternoon (some locations may not swim every day). The afternoon swim portion is fully supervised by our camp staff and professional pool facility lifeguards. There are limited spaces for the 'swim' option to ensure supervision ratios are safe and pool regulations met. At some locations, campers aged 5 to 7 may not be able to choose the 'swim' option due to pool restrictions. If you have any swim concerns, speak to your onsite Supervisor or contact us at 1-800-427-0536. There might not be any soccer played in the afternoon sessions.

- U7 Division 2016, 2015 and 2014 born players. 10 half-rink floor times and 4 full-rink floor times; focus is on introduction to the game and skill development.
- U9 Division 2013 and 2012 born players. 2 half-rink practices and 12 full-rink games plus single elimination playoffs.
- U11 Division2011 and 2010 born players. 2 practices and 12 games plus single elimination playoffs.
- U13 Division 2009 and 2008 born players. 1 practice and 13 games plus single elimination playoffs
- U15 Division 2007 and 2006 born players. 1 practice and 13 games plus single elimination playoffs
- U17 Division 2005 and 2004 born players. 1 practice and 13 games plus single elimination playoffs
- U14 Female Division 2009, 2008 and 2007 2 practices and 12 games plus single elimination playoffs

Game and Season Information

- Games are played at indoor hockey rinks throughout Winnipeg, there are **NO SET LOCATIONS**. Rink locations will vary by game.
- Game days will be scheduled Monday to Thursday as well as Sundays (if necessary). Game days and times will vary from week to week. **NO SET DAYS.**
- Average of two floor times per week; earliest start time is 6:00pm during the week. Younger divisions will get the earlier start times.
- Games will be two 20-minute periods (run time) with five players and a goalie on the floor per team.
- Division adjustments will be made after five games to ensure skill levels are as close as possible.
- Season begins May 2nd, 2021 and finishes at the end of June 2021.

Player Fee Information


- U7 Division cost is \$125, this includes 14 floor times and a team T-Shirt.
- All other division cost is \$250, which includes 14 floor times (plus playoffs) and a team jersey they will keep.
- Full team registration cost is \$3,600. Team General Manager must collect money and turn in before deadline. (12 min players to 19 player max); \$3400 if team supplies its own jerseys (league must approve color, logo and name).
- Registration Deadline is April 12th, 2021. No refunds after registration deadline.

Mandatory Equipment

- CSA approved hockey helmet with full facial protection
- Hockey gloves and ice hockey stick (no plastic blades)
- Soccer style shin guards or ball hockey shin guards
- Athletic cup
- Soft elbow and knee pads are recommended.
