Today Manitoba's Chief Provincial Health Officer Dr. Brent Roussin extended the period of Code Red operation for all Winnipeg schools for at least another week. June 7th is now the earliest that schools would reopen for more than very limited in-person learning.

All students in grades 7 to 12 will continue to learn remotely. All students in Kindergarten through Grade 6 will also learn remotely unless their parents are in critical service occupations as defined by Manitoba Public Health <u>and</u> unable to make child care arrangements. Schools have also invited a small number of students whose circumstances warrant it to attend in-person.

Our schools will continue to do their utmost to support our students. Please continue to cooperate with public health orders and please get vaccinated. Our schools will get back to the busy, boisterous, social places we love.
