Dear Parents,

Friday, September 17, 2021

As we complete our first full week of school, everyone is beginning to learn and remember the regular routines at West St. Paul School. The school bus arrivals, transfers and departures are working, and students and teachers are getting back in the groove of school. Everyone is happy and grateful to have students back at school as we continue to live through this COVID pandemic.

All COVID protocols we practiced last year continue to exist – masking indoors, washing and sanitizing hands often, classroom cohorts, increased school ventilation, teaching outdoors and social distancing. Teachers continue to speak to students about personal safety as well as the safety of their friends, family and public. We all need to work together to prevent a wave of illness like last year.

More students can take the school bus this year which has reduced some of the traffic dropping students off in the loop beside the school. We strongly discourage parents from dropping and picking their children on the shoulder of the highway. Hiawatha and Minnehaha Avenues remain as options for parents to drop off, pick up or park and walk to get their children. We have an adult crossing children and families at the traffic light both before and after school.

Please take a moment to log on to Parent Connect and review your responses to the 2021-2022 consent forms. Responses to the consent forms now roll over yearly. This means that the responses you entered last year have carried forward to this year. If you have transferred to West St. Paul School from another school within the Seven Oaks School Division, you will need to respond to the Responsible Use of Technology form as this is one form that does not carry forward.
