Seven Oaks Immigrant Services (SOIS) help newcomer individuals and families in the North-West Winnipeg community and beyond by offering information, support systems, enhanced skills and community connections that aids their integration into life in Canada. We do this to empower immigrants and our community to be healthy and thrive. Under the direction of the Program Director and ESL Coordinator, the ESL instructor provides language instruction to adult refugees and immigrants. SOIS is part of a national network of LINC (Language Instruction for Newcomers to Canada) programs.

Overview:

The English as a Second Language program runs from Monday to Thursday with full week and part time classes, in the morning, afternoon and evenings. Teachers in the program are paid on an hourly basis.

Qualifications and Skills:

- Certificate in Teachers of English as a Second or Foreign Language (CTESL)
- Bachelor's degree or equivalent
- Willingness to complete training in Canadian Language Benchmarks (CLB) and Portfolio Based Language Assessment (PBLA) if not already completed.
- Teaching reading, writing, listening, and speaking.
- Working with adult and ESL learners

Able to:

- provide differentiated instruction.
- implement PBLA into classroom teaching and assessment.
- develop original targeted materials.
- build a communicative classroom.
- create a supportive and engaging learning environment.

Understands:

- Adult learning theory.
- Literacy learning theory.
- Language acquisition theory.

Positions are casual and contract based paying \$43.78/hour, operating from September to June, excludes school breaks.
