To be eligible for these positions applicants must be at least 16 years of age as of June 30, 2024

BEEP is offering no-cost programming for early-years learners to provide exciting and authentic learning experiences in 2 two-week sessions throughout July and August. Working as part of a site-based team (Coordinators, Teachers, Facilitators and Mentors). Each of the school sites will plan, organize and provide enriching learning opportunities for early-years learners during the summer. Summer Mentors at each site will work as a team (Site Coordinator, Teachers, Facilitators and Support Workers) to provide quality summer programming in a safe and enriching environment.

Employment Dates: July 2 - August 9, 2024 (with training opportunities available in June 2024)

Summer Mentors will work alongside teachers to provide rich, fun and engaging experiences for students. Mentors should be prepared to enhance and support all program activities while building trusting relationships with program participants. Desired qualifications include:

- Relevant experience in working with youth (paid work or volunteer). This experience should include serving as a positive role model, advocate and support inclusion and learning for all program participants.
- Interest and ability to demonstrate leadership skills as part of your work with youth.
- Interest and experience in working as a part of a team, including planning, organizing and leading activities.
- Interest in bringing personal interests and talents to the program to support program activities.
- Be 16 years of age or older prior to employment start date.
