BOARD-SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENT RELATIONS

The Superintendent shall be the chief executive officer of the Board and shall be responsible for the professional leadership and skill necessary to translate the will of the Board into administrative action.

The Superintendent shall be responsible for all aspects of school operation and for such duties and powers pertaining thereto as the Board may direct or delegate. He/she may delegate responsibility and the authority necessary to discharge it to other officials and so develop such procedures and regulations as considered necessary to ensure efficient operation of the Division.

The Board assumes that the Superintendent is professionally able and possesses outstanding qualities of leadership, vision, and administrative skill and that he/she will implement all policies of the Board in good faith.

The Superintendent can assume that the Board will respect his/her professional competence and extend full responsibility for implementation of Board policy decisions. In order that the Superintendent may provide effective leadership, the Board will delegate to the Superintendent those powers which it considers advisable so to do. He/she can expect the Board to support his/her decisions and administration of the school system.
