## THROUGH THE SCHOOLS

Frequently external non-profit organizations wish to use the schools to distribute material advertising their programs. While the Board wishes to co-operate with such organizations it feels that this type of distribution can easily get out of hand. Accordingly, the Board sets out the following provisions.

- 1. Distribution of all external organizational material through the schools to pupils must have the approval of the Superintendent or his/her designate.
- 2. Generally, only local organizations providing service of an educational or recreational nature will be considered.
- 3. Content of material and/or program being advertised must conform to community standards and Board policy.
- 4. Materials to be distributed to students must be counted and bundled in classroom sets by the organization before they will be accepted.
- 5. A denial of this privilege by the Superintendent may be appealed to the Board.
