Open during weekdays including evenings and weekends to meet the unexpected healthcare needs of individuals and their family during times when most other clinics are closed.

Clinic Hours:

Monday to Friday: 12PM to 7:30PM Saturdays and Sundays: 9AM to 4:30PM Statutory Holidays: 9AM to 4:30PM

It has registered nurses and nurse practitioners who can diagnose and treat minor health issues and can also prescribe medication for the conditions they are assessing.

Health issues that can be treated include:

- bumps, bruises, or sprains;
- rashes, eczema, infected cuts, or minor sores:
- sore throat, earache, colds and flu, cough, hay fever, or nose bleeds;
- immunizations;
- sore eyes with redness or infection; stomach pain, diarrhea and vomiting, urinary infections, or indigestion;
- urinary infections, or indigestion; headache, back pain, or neck pain;
- birth control or breast feeding issues;
 - and stress or anxiety.
