Chères familles de l'école Rivière-Rouge:

The safety of your child and all children in our school as well as the safety of our school staff is very important to us. To maintain a safe environment for our children to study and learn, it is necessary that we practice our “lockdown drill” twice a year.

A lockdown is designed to protect students and staff members in a situation in which there might be threats of violence within a school. During a lockdown, students remain in their classrooms or are escorted to classrooms if they are in the halls, and all interior and exterior doors are closed and locked. Once the facility is rendered safe and students are accounted for, the school is returned to normal operation. Training helps ensure a calmer, more effective lockdown.

We would like to inform you that our school has conducted a lockdown today. This drill is generally short, typically lasting no longer than a fire drill.

We will continue to keep you informed of safety and security measures that are in place for École Rivière-Rouge.
