Top Ten Ways for Our Community to Stay Safe

- 1. If your child displays any cold or flu-like symptoms, they are expected to remain at home and families are asked to call our office. Please see reopening plan for list of symptoms.
- 2. If a student arrives at school, or becomes symptomatic, the student will be isolated in a safe space and the family will be contacted to immediately pick up their child.
- 3. Staff and students will wash their hands frequently with soap & water or hand sanitizer.
- 4. Staff, Visitors and Students in Grade 4 and up are required to wear masks while in the school. Younger students may wear masks if their guardian deems appropriate and is highly encouraged.
- 5. Respect social/physical distancing of 2m when possible.
- 6. Please do not drop off your child before 8:45-9:00. Please meet your child at the end of school day 3:30, at designated location.
- 7. Please drop off/pick-up your child one block away from the school and have them walk the remaining distance. Alternatively choose a spot away from entrances on the playground or sidewalk. Please do not use the staff parking lot for drop off/pick-up, as this is not a safe space.
- 8. Parents/Guardians and community members are asked not to enter the school unless they have made an appointment with the school office or classroom teacher.
- 9. Students only Enter/Exit the building through the entry way closest to their classroom. Please see school map at end of reopening document.
- 10. We are all learners. We know that there will be times where we don't understand the new guidelines. What's most important is that we take these opportunities as moments to teach one another and know that in time we will develop a new rhythm.
