Do you have (or know of someone who has) a child born in 2018? **Kindergarten registration for the 2022/2023 school year** begins on February 27th, 2023. Families have the choice of registering **online or in-person (by appointment)**. For online registration, go to the Seven Oaks School Division website, starting February 27th. For in-person registration, call our school office to book your appointment. Please bring your child's birth certificate, passport or baptismal certificate, your Manitoba healthcare card #'s, as well as two proofs of your current address such as a driver's license, lease agreement or a utility bills.



REGISTRATION FOR 2023-2024

Kindergarten registration begins on Monday, February 27, 2023 for all children born in 2018. You must register at your catchment school. Please register on-line at www.7oaks.org under the kindergarten registration tab or you can make an in-person appointment with the school to set up a time. You will need to provide your child's birth certificate or valid passport along with two proofs of address showing your name and address. Acceptable documents are any two utility bills, or one utility bill and one Shaw bill which shows address, rental or lease agreement, driver's license.

Seven Oaks School Division also offers education instructed in the following languages:

Ojibwe, Filipino, French and Ukrainian

Should you wish to enrol your child in a language program, please call us at the school. We can provide you with information regarding the catchment/home school for that particular language you choose.



HELP US KEEP STUDENTS AND FAMILY SAFE!

We cannot stress enough the importance to not park in the school parking lot. It is a safety hazard. Please use the "STOP, DROP & GO" doors (middle doors) or you can pick up/drop off your child at the office doors or the west doors all on Jefferson Ave.

PATROL INFORMATION

Cold weather clothing and shift guidelines when the temperature OR windchill are as follows:

- -9 or above: Patrols go out for their regular shifts of 15 minutes on post Warm jackets, boots, hats, and mitts are commended.
- -10 to -27: Patrols do regular shifts. They MUST wear ski/snowpants, warm jacket, boots, hats and mitts/gloves.
- -27 to -34: Patrols will do a reduced shifts (5-10 minutes depending on weather conditions). Patrols MUST wear all winter clothing as said above.
- -35 or colder: Patrols WILL NOT go out on post.


In Social Studies, we learned about the Ice Ages and the First Peoples of Canada. We researched and made 3D models, of our First Peoples communities.
