Students will receive a poppy to wear on Remembrance Day. If you would like to send in a small donation for the poppy, please send it with your child to their classroom teacher before November 10th.


Remembrance Day is on Thursday, November 11th, and therefore it is not a school day.

A big thank you goes out to all the families who were able to fundraise for the Terry Fox Foundation! Your time and generosity is greatly appreciated and is a step towards Terry's ultimate hope!

In celebration of Terry Fox's marathon of hope, Victory classrooms participated in a Class Lap Challenge during Phys. Ed. Class. Each class ran for 26 minutes (in honour of Terry Fox's 26 mile run per day). At the end of the run, we tallied the class score and converted the number of laps into distance.
